Instructions for the use, care, transport and storage of large-scale textile advertising images

Please take into account that large-scale textile advertising materials are exposed to weather and environmental stress. In order to ensure proper product life and safe use, please observe the following instructions:

1. Location conditions

The size of the advertising space, the selection of the basic materials, the finish and assembly technology, have a decisive influence on the correct and safe use of the product.

With large images, as a fundamental rule, we recommend involving a project planner who is familiar with local conditions.

The product guarantee covers guaranteed resistance to tearing, light-fastness and washability under standardized laboratory conditions.

For products with a surface area of less than 270 ft² (25m²), we shall gladly advise you regarding finish and assembly. For products with a surface area of more than 270 ft² (25m²), you should by all means have project planning carried out. Liability of the manufacturer as a result of failure to observe the conditions of use and incorrect assembly is excluded.

Digital large images must be assembled in such a manner that contact with other objects is prevented. All securing points (e.g. eyelets, grommets) must be used individually, in order to properly absorb the forces present and to distribute them evenly.

2. Care

The cleaning of large images with PVC coating is only possible by rinsing with water. Due to the solvent-containing pigment printing process, textile materials are not washable and no other form of cleaning is recommended. For products with additional lamination, an extension of the UV stability and a higher level of surface protection against mechanical stress is given.

Damage occurring should be repaired immediately in order to stop premature wear and tear.

3. Storage and transport

Digital large images must only be stored or transported rolled or laid out flat when in a dry condition. Short-term folding or laying together can lead to cracks in the image. Please request and observe information on the recommendations of the manufacturer related to the basic materials.
